We will accept applications at this time through noon, March 12, 2021, for the open positions.

In accordance with our By-Laws and Procedures for Conducting an Annual Meeting, you are invited to submit an application for a Board of Director position. Each position will serve a three-year term beginning at the Annual Meeting in April 2021. To be qualified a person must:

- be 18 years of age as of the date of election to the Board;
- **be A MEMBER OF CROSS TIMBERS WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION IN ORDER TO SERVE AS A BOARD MEMBER;**
- not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
- not been finally convicted of a felony or if convicted, was pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- supply biographical information about yourself; and
- obtain 20 or more original signatures from CTWSC members supporting your application for Board Director.

An application form is attached for use in applying. All applications must be received in the offices of Cross Timbers Water Supply Corporation at 2032 E. Hickory Hill Road, Argyle, TX 76226 no later than noon on March 12, 2021. Applications may be mailed or dropped off in our offices or in the drop box located next to our offices.
